Our Story

YoursCancerCare was born from a simple, painful observation: in India, 1.4 million people are diagnosed with cancer every year — and most face the fight without a clear roadmap. Patients and families are left guessing about treatment options, realistic costs, government schemes that can pay for care, recruiting clinical trials, and even what to eat during chemotherapy.

We built YoursCancerCare to change that. In under a minute, anyone — regardless of city, language or income — can get a personalised, India-aware care plan that explains their treatment in plain language, surfaces the government schemes they qualify for, lists clinical trials near them, builds a calorie- and protein-targeted Indian diet, and connects them to verified crowdfunding when treatment is unaffordable.

The platform is free, requires no sign-up, stores nothing on a server, and is available in English, Tamil, Telugu, Kannada and Malayalam. It exists because a cancer diagnosis should never come without a roadmap.

Why You Can Trust Us

Built on global & Indian clinical guidelines

Every treatment protocol summarised on YoursCancerCare is derived from internationally recognised, peer-reviewed clinical guidelines — NCCN (USA), ESMO (Europe), WHO, and India-specific guidance from ICMR and Tata Memorial Centre.

Real, government-sourced scheme data

Government scheme information (PMJAY/Ayushman Bharat, RAN, HMCPF, CGHS, state schemes) is sourced directly from official Government of India and state-government portals.

Live clinical trial data

Recruiting clinical trials are surfaced live from ClinicalTrials.gov, the U.S. National Library of Medicine's registry — the global standard for trial transparency.

Verified fundraising platforms only

We list only established, regulated Indian crowdfunding platforms (Ketto, ImpactGuru, Milaap, GivelIndia) that publish transparent fee structures and KYC processes. We earn no commission from any platform.

Privacy by design

Your medical profile lives only in your browser's local storage. We do not run trackers on medical pages, do not sell data to advertisers, and do not require an account.

Free and non-commercial

YoursCancerCare is provided free of charge. We do not sell treatments, refer patients to specific hospitals for payment, or accept paid placements.

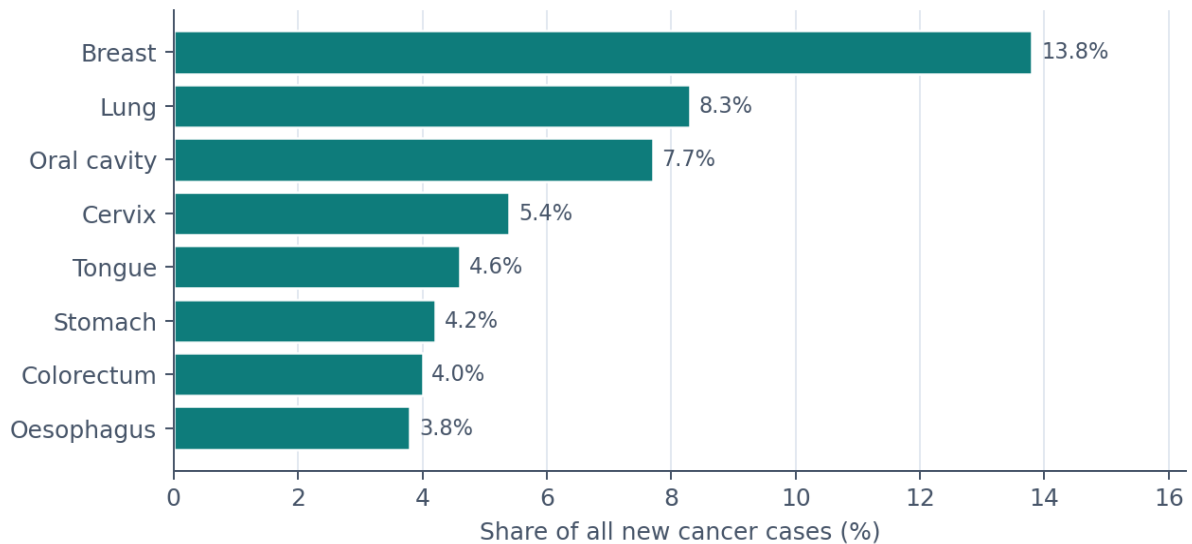
Cancer in India — Key Data & Visual Analytics

The numbers below come from ICMR-NCRP (India's National Cancer Registry Programme), GLOBOCAN 2022 (IARC / WHO), and SEER. They explain why we built YoursCancerCare and why every Indian family deserves a clear roadmap from day one.

Why this matters — 8 facts every Indian family should know

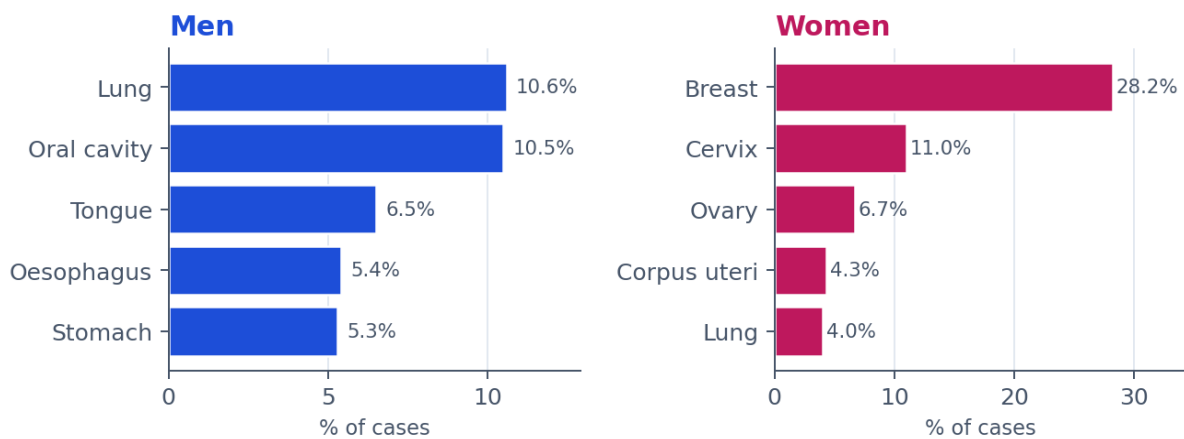
- **~1.46 million** new cancer cases are diagnosed in India every year (ICMR-NCRP 2022) — roughly **1 every 22 seconds**.
- **1 in 9 Indians** will develop cancer in their lifetime; cases are projected to cross **1.7 million per year by 2030**.
- **Breast cancer** is now the most common cancer overall in India — **28.2%** of all cancers in women.
- **Tobacco-related cancers** (oral cavity, tongue, lung, oesophagus) make up **~27%** of all cancers in Indian men — almost entirely preventable.
- **Cervical cancer** kills ~77,000 Indian women a year, yet is highly preventable with HPV vaccination and screening.
- Only about **1 in 3** Indian cancer patients survive 5 years — vs. ~2 in 3 in high-income countries — mostly because of **late detection**.
- Out-of-pocket costs push **~55 million Indians** into poverty every year due to medical bills; cancer is a leading driver.
- **PMJAY (Ayushman Bharat)** covers cancer treatment up to **₹5 lakh per family per year** — but a large share of eligible patients never claim it because they don't know it exists.

Most common cancers in India



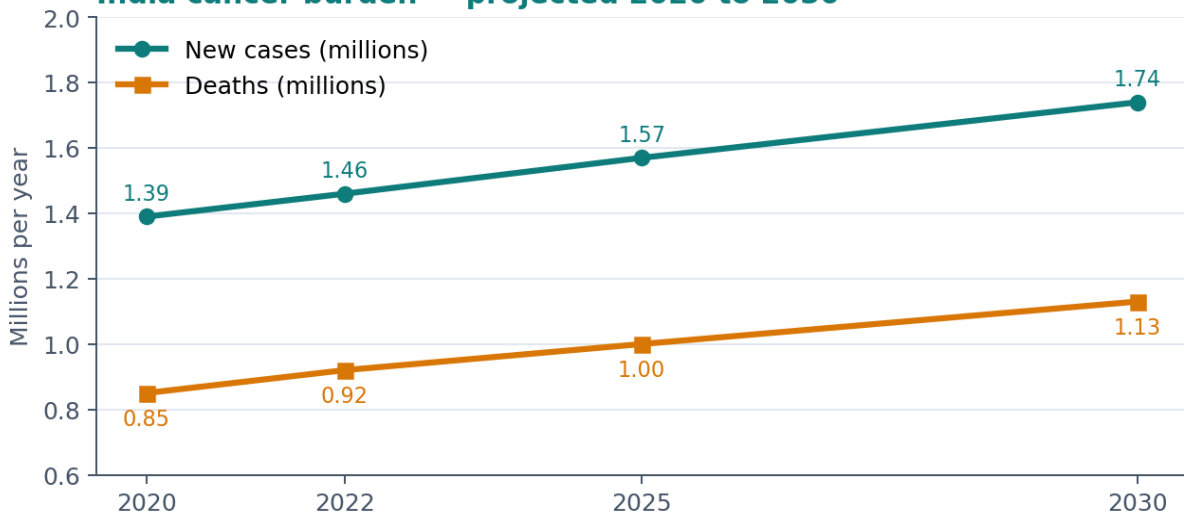
